Dear Mrs. Pritchard:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to put the water to full beneficial use for the reason(s) below:

- As noted in your letter, and in our phone call on May 27, 2022, Walla Walla County has not repaired the bridge that is delivering power to your irrigation system, and instead is using a mobile bridge unit from the Army Corps of Engineers.
- Be advised that the State Water Code requires that your project be pursued with diligence. It is important that development of your project continue within the time prescribed in this authorization.

The new deadline to submit your *Proof of Appropriation of Water* is **May 1, 2025**.

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this action to the Pollution Control Hearing Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document. The appeal process is governed by Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this document:

- File your appeal and a copy of this document with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this document on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) Email is not accepted.



You must also comply with other applicable requirements in Chapter 43.21B RCW and Chapter 371-08 WAC.
