Dear Zine Badissy:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension to complete construction for the reason(s) below:

- The applicant has demonstrated good faith and reasonable diligence through their efforts to construct and drill a well on the property, and attempts to hire certified drillers and contractors.
- The applicant has demonstrated good cause due to unanticipated engineering problems related to the construction of wells, which has delayed the original development schedule.
- The extension will allow the applicants more time to find a new well driller and complete construction since COVID-19 has greatly affected the original construction schedule due to supply chain, material cost, and labor shortage issues.

The new deadline to submit your *Construction Notice* is **December 31, 2026**.

Provision 2. shall be updated as follows:

"2. Required installation and maintenance of an access port as described in WAC 173-160- 291(3)."

Provision 3. shall be updated as follows:

"3. All wells constructed in the state shall meet the "Minimum Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Wells" (WAC 173-160) and "Water Well Construction" (RCW 18.104). In general, wells shall be located at least 100 feet from sources of contamination and at least 1,000 feet of the boundary of a solid waste landfill. Any well which is unusable, abandoned, or is an environmental, safety, or public health hazard shall be decommissioned."

Provision 4. shall be updated as follows:

"4. An approved measuring device must be installed and maintained for each of the sources identified by this water right in accordance with the rule "Requirements for Measuring and Reporting Water Use", WAC 173-173, which describes the requirements for data accuracy, device installation and operation, and information reporting. It also allows a water user to petition the Department of Ecology for modifications to some of the requirements.

Recorded water use data shall be submitted via the Internet. To set up an Internet reporting account, contact the Regional Office. If you do not have Internet access, you can still submit hard copies by contacting the Regional Office for forms to submit your water use data."

New provision 12. shall be added as follows:

"12. All wells shall be tagged with a Department of Ecology unique well identification number. If you have an existing well and it does not have a tag, please contact the well-drilling coordinator at the regional Department of Ecology office issuing this decision. This tag shall remain attached to the well. If you are required to submit water measuring reports, reference this tag number."

YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL

You have a right to appeal this Decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision. The appeal process is governed by chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC.
