RE: Your request to reduce the annual volume of Temporary Change Authorization
CS1-SWC180(A)@14, King County, Water Resources Inventory Area 7

Dear Steven Sweet:

On May 9, 2022, the Department of Ecology (Ecology) received your request for a reduction in the approved annual volume of Temporary Change Authorization CS1-SWC180(A)@14. You requested a reduction in the approved annual volume from 2 acre-feet per year (ac-ft/yr) to 0.5 ac-ft/yr for the remainder of the Temporary Change Authorization, which expires on October 31, 2023. You also requested the difference (1.5 ac-ft/yr) be returned to CS1-*01933(A)@1, which is currently in the Trust Water Rights Program (TWRP).

You did not request to change any other attributes, terms, or conditions of CS1-SWC180(A)@14, as issued for use on property owned by Howard Richmond.

DEPARTMENT OF ECOLOGY DECISION & ACCEPTANCE

Your request for a reduction in the annual volume of CS1-SWC180(A)@14 from 2.0 ac-ft/yr to 0.5 ac-ft/yr is hereby **APPROVED**. Your request to return 1.5 ac-ft/yr to the TWRP under CS1-*01933(A)@1 has been **ACCEPTED**. The annual volume now held in the TWRP under CS1-*01933(A)@1 is 854.3 ac-ft/yr (47.21 ac-ft/yr consumptive). The instantaneous rate in the TWRP under CS1-*01933(A)@1 remains unchanged at 1.406 cubic feet per second.

No changes to any other attributes, terms, or conditions of CS1-SWC180(A)@14 were requested nor have been approved.

Your Right To Appeal

To appeal, you must do the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of the Order:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Order with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Order to Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person (see addresses below). E-mail is not accepted.


You must also comply with other applicable requirements in chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC.
