CONSUMPTIVE USE CALCULATION:

Outdoor Use: The requestor/applicant proposes to irrigate 100.1 acres of orchard. Of that orchard 94.1 acres are in apples with cover and the additional 6 acres are pears with cover. Using a crop irrigation requirement of 42.42 in/yr (or 3.535 ft/yr) for apples with cover near Yakima and 39.25 in/yr (or 3.27 ft/yr) for pear & plum with cover from the Washington Irrigation Guide and an application efficiency of 75%, the total outdoor irrigation water use is 469.69 ac-ft/yr. Consistent with Ecology Guidance 1210, 85% of outdoor use is consumptively used, therefore: **outdoor consumptive use** = **399.23 ac-ft/yr.**

NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

The project area is located south of Rattlesnake Ridge. The property is historically irrigated using Union Gap Irrigation District (UGID) water but because of the slow moving landside, the UGID cannot serve this property at this time. UGID is trying to find solutions to get water to all of their customers, including the applicant. This application is to allow the applicant to irrigate their orchard if UGID cannot get water to them by the beginning of the 2019 irrigation season. If UGID can deliver water to the property then the applicant will not use the well.

The applicant proposes to offset the 399.23 ac-ft of consumptive use for the project by leaving their UGID shares instream.

Ecology's technical unit reviewed the proposed project and in their report said "Overall, withdrawals from the proposed pumping of well would result in impacts that would not impair neighboring groundwater users."
