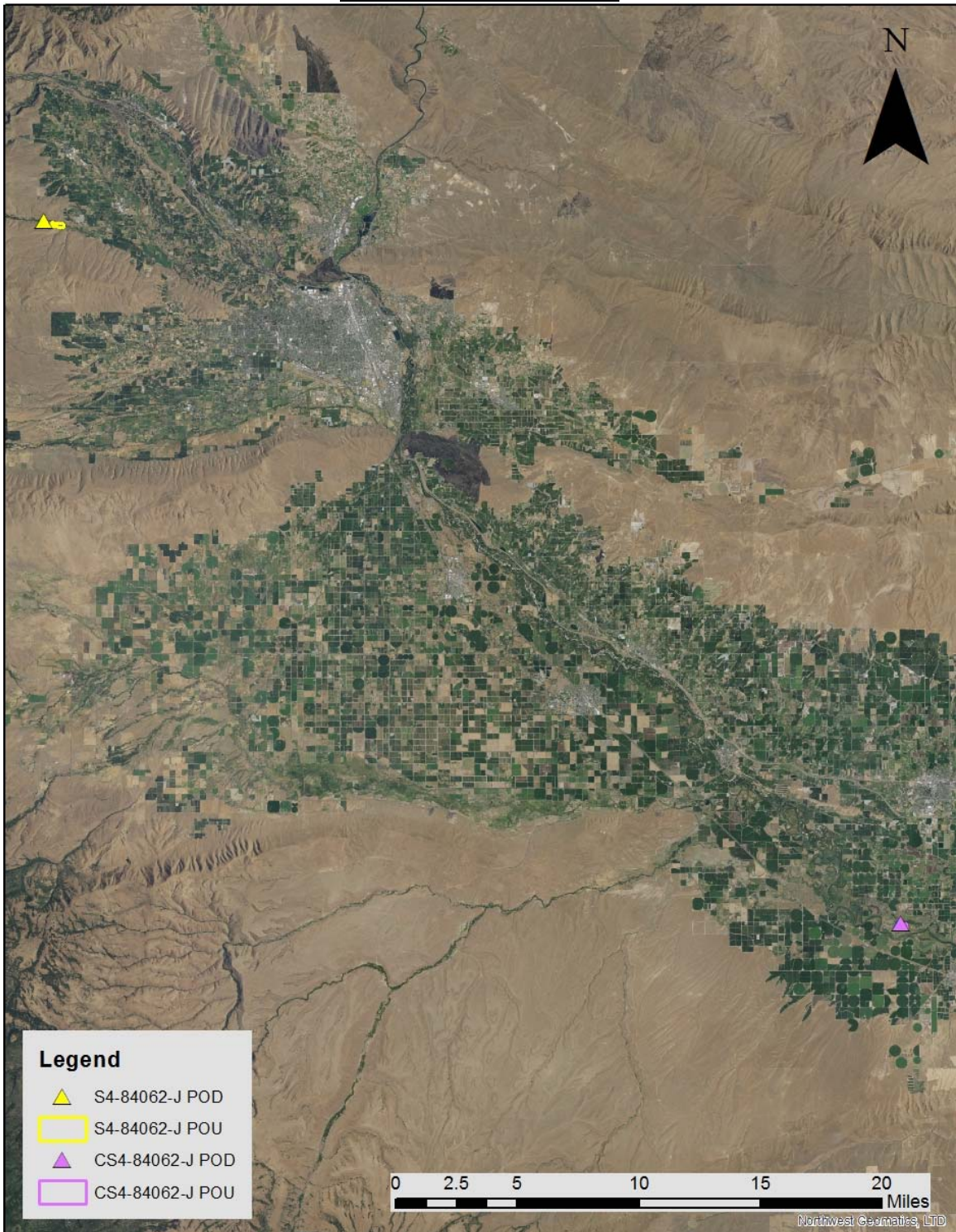

| NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: The Washington Department of Fish and Wildlife (WDFW) submitted a seasonal change application to change the place of use and point of diversion of S4-84062-J downstream to the Sunnyside Wildlife Area. WDFW plans to take water out of Giffin lake to irrigate 32 acres of wildlife habitat in the new place of use. There is only one other water right that diverts water from Giffin Lake, S4-84003-J, which is in WDFW's name and is for habitat improvement from November 1-April 15. S4-84062-J has been in the state trust water right program since 2009. Ecology believes that this transfer will not impair any existing rights. |
