NARRATIVE DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT: This is a seasonal change application to transfer a portion of S4-83378-J to irrigate five (5) acres immediately adjacent of the original place of use for the 2021 irrigation season. There is no proposed change to the existing point of diversion located at within the SW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Sec. 4, TWP. 15 N., RGE. 15 E.W.M. The applicant's property does not currently have water rights. This seasonal change will allow the

applicant to irrigate a portion, five (5) acres of his 6.91 acre parcel. The water will be utilized for the propagation of Alfalfa. This seasonal change will result in the fallowing of 5 acres from Yakima County Parcel No. 15163433002. There is no regulator history for S4-83398-J not being fulfilled. Ecology believes that this transfer will not impair any existing rights.

Location of CS4-83378-J

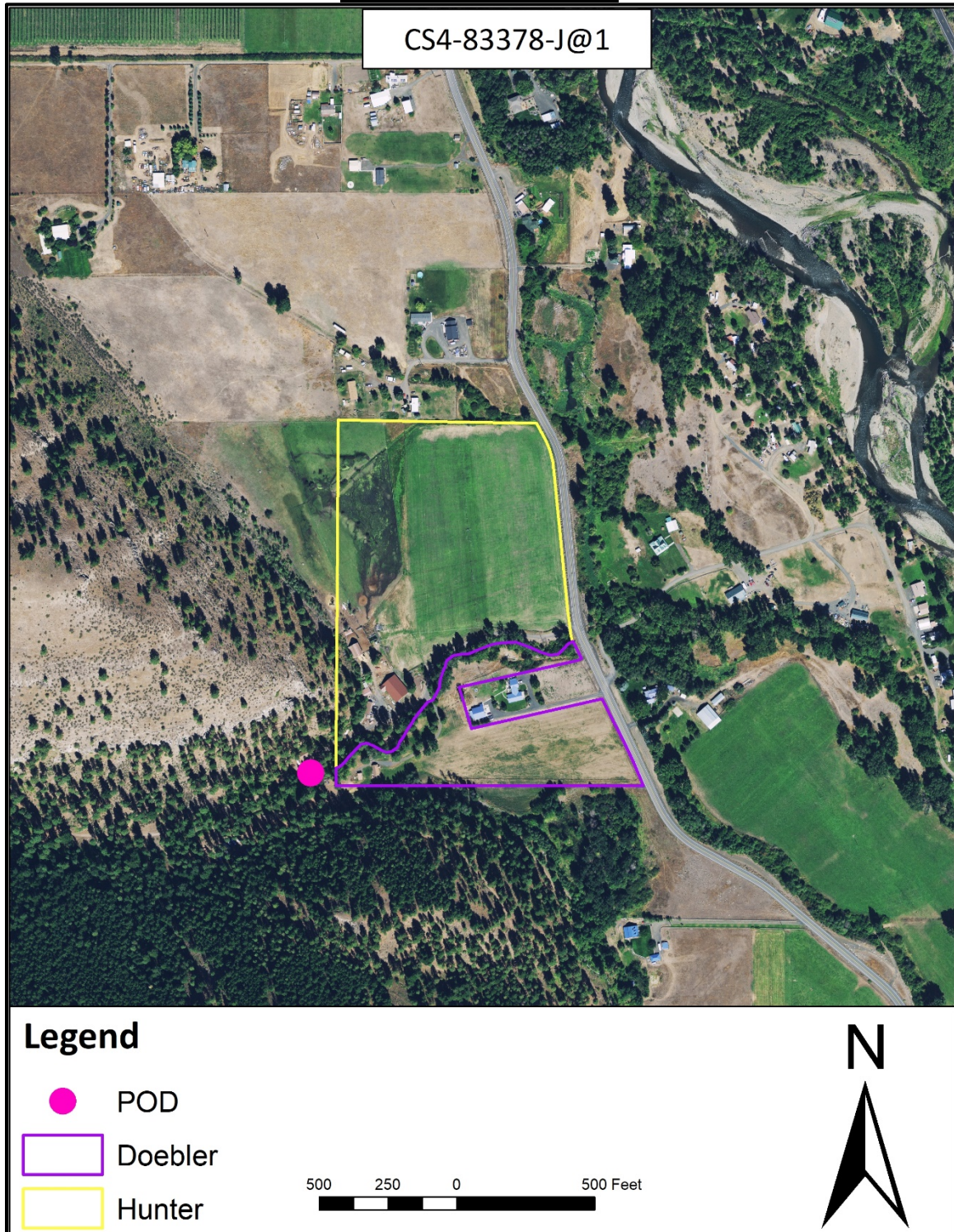


Figure 1. Map with original place of use (Hunter property outlined in yellow) and the location of the proposed transfer property (Doebler property outlined in purple).
