Dear Russ Johnson:

In response to your request, you are hereby granted an extension of the above referenced Trust Water Donation to remain in the Trust Water Right Program for an additional six (6) years. Your donation is extended as summarized below:

<b>Benefiting Water Body</b>	Groundwater
<b>Purpose</b>	Groundwater Preservation
<b>Rate</b>	0.28 CFS (125.6 GPM)*
<b>Acre-Feet Per Year</b>	69.4*
<b>Season</b>	05/01 – 10/31
<b>Water Right Place of Use</b>	Within the NE¼SE¼ and those portions of the SE¼NE¼, SW¼NE¼ and NW¼SE¼ which lie south and east of the Methow River, and southerly of the Burma Road right of way in Section 13, T. 30 N., R. 22 E.W.M., AND; the SW¼, W¼SW¼SE¼; and that portion of Government Lot 4 lying southerly of the Burma Road right of way in Section 18, T. 30 N., R. 23 E.W.M.

\* Applicant is retaining 0.08 cfs (35.9 GPM) 20 acre-feet per year for the irrigation of 5 acres of remaining lawn and orchard.

**This trust water right expires on December 31, 2028.**

**YOUR RIGHT TO APPEAL**

You have a right to appeal this Decision to the Pollution Control Hearings Board (PCHB) within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision. The appeal process is governed by chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC. "Date of receipt" is defined in RCW 43.21B.001(2).

To appeal you must do all of the following within 30 days of the date of receipt of this Decision:

- File your appeal and a copy of this Decision with the PCHB (see addresses below). Filing means actual receipt by the PCHB during regular business hours.
- Serve a copy of your appeal and this Decision on Ecology in paper form - by mail or in person. (See addresses below.) E-mail is not accepted.

You must also comply with other applicable requirements in chapter 43.21B RCW and chapter 371-08 WAC.
