


NWS Water Supply Forecasts

- Most locations showing near normal water volumes, but varies from well below to well above
- Almost all locations showing above 85% to 100% of normal water volumes
- Methow and Palouse areas are exceptions with low 705% of normal
- Snow pack generally below normal to normal but varies widely from much below to much above normal
- Outlook is mixed for water supply
 - Warmer than normal likely
 - Precipitation equal chances of above or below






