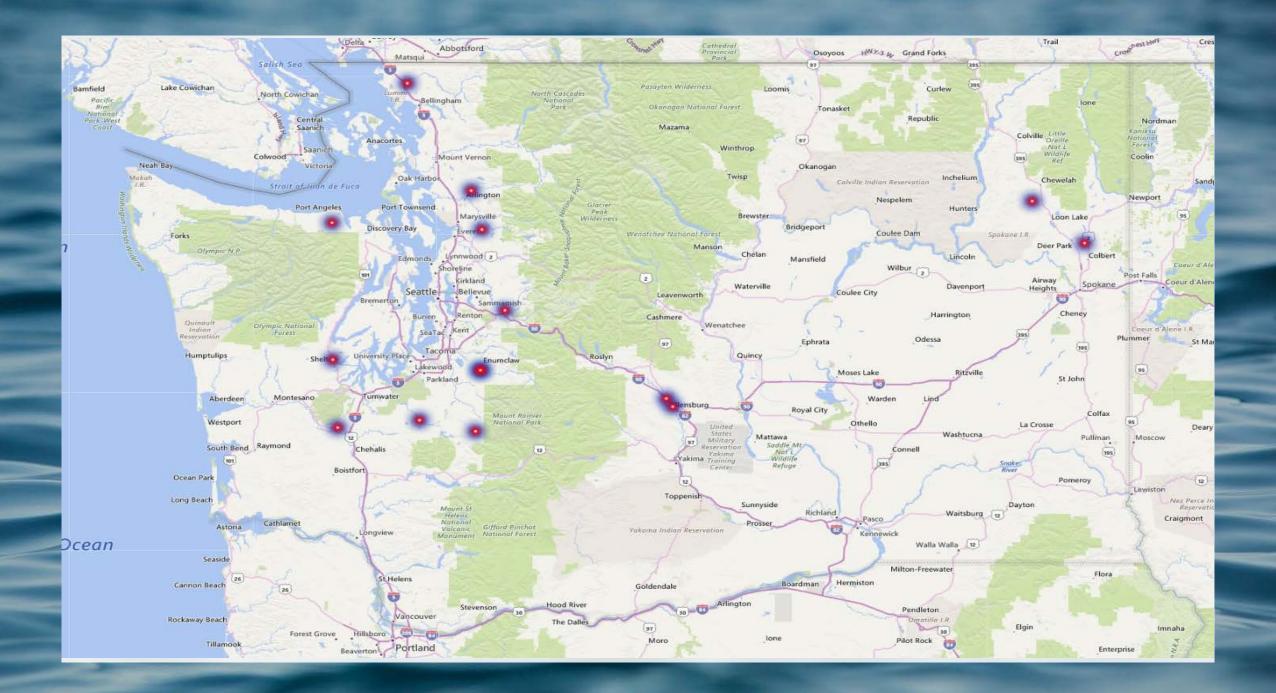




90.94 Project Grants Pilot Round Offers Sent January 2019

- ~\$20 Million Available 2019
- 15 Projects
- Evaluation Ecology and WDFW
- Guidance Priorities:
 - Water Projects higher priority
 - Water acquisition.
 - Water storage..
 - Altered water management (e.g. conservation /infrastructure)
 - Non-water Projects lower priority
 - Protects/improves instream resources but do not replace water.
