<ul> <li>do not have adopted watershed plans</li> <li>have instream flow rules that do not regulate permit- exempt wells</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>allowed 950 gallons per day as the maximum annual average (350 gallons per day during drought)</li> <li>subject to a \$500 fee</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>are directed by Section 203 of the new law to adopt watershed restoration and enhancement plans by 2021</li> </ul>	

## No new regulations

WRIAs 5 (Stillaguamish); 17 (Quilcene-Snow); 18 (Elwha-Dungeness); 27 (Lewis); 28 (Salmon-Washougal); 32 (Walla Walla); 45 (Wenatchee); 46 (Entiat); 48 (Methow); and 57 (Middle Spokane)

These watersheds have existing instream flow rules that regulate permit-exempt uses. The new water use limits, \$500 fees, and basin planning under the law do not apply in these watersheds.

WRIAs **37** (Lower Yakima), **38** (Naches), **39** (Upper Yakima), **3** (Lower Skagit), and **4** (Upper Skagit)
