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Streamflow Restoration Competitive Grants Overview


15 Year Competitive Grant Offering \$300 M Legislatively Authorized











Competitive Grants: Two Rounds Complete






Watershed planning and project funding across the state



3rd Competitive Grant Round

- Extremely minor changes to 2nd round grant guidance
- \$40 Million Available
- Eligible Applicants: Washington state agencies, local governments and quasi-governments within Washington state, agencies of the federal government, tribal governments with reservation lands or treaty rights within Washington, and non-profit organizations Out-of-state agencies and organizations, and for-profit companies are not eligible to apply for these competitive grants.
- Eligible Project Types:
 - (a) Protect and enhance streamflows.
 - (b) Improve watershed functions that benefit instream fish and wildlife resources.
 - (c) Offset the consumptive use impacts from new domestic permit exempt wells.
 - (d) Implement projects identified in a plan or rule adopted to meet the requirements of RCW 90.94.020, .030, or .040
- As in past versions, the application scoring criteria published in chapter 3 of the grants guidance



3rd Competitive Grant Round Funding Priorities

Funding program priorities are consistent with WAC 173-566-150 and Chapter 90.94 RCW

- Geographic location
 - Planning WRIA
 - Metering Pilot
- Projects identified:
 - In an adopted watershed plan; or
 - Through a rulemaking process
- Projects that improve streamflows
- Projects that benefit:
 - Threatened and endangered salmonids; or
 - Other native fish and aquatic species of concern





Approximate Percent of Number of Requests by Region (some projects span multiple counties and regions)





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
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
