THIS MATTER has come on regularly before the Court with the United States presenting its state law claims related to the U.S. Forest Service, Toppenish National Wildlife Refuge and Yakima Firing Center. This Court filed its Report of the Court Concerning the Water Rights for the United States of America U.S. Forest Service, Toppenish National Wildlife Refuge and Yakima Firing Center on July 15, 2004. Thereafter, this Court held a hearing on April 14, 2005, regarding exceptions to that report. Attorney Charles Shockey represented the United States, Assistant Attorney General Sharonne O'Shea represented the Department of Ecology, and Attorney Jeffrey S. Schuster represented the Yakama Nation. Richard K. Stiles presented his exception pro se.

The Court, after reviewing the exceptions and other materials, and after hearing argument and being fully advised, on October 5, 2005, filed its <u>Supplemental Report of the Court Concerning the Water Rights for the United States of America, U.S. Forest Service and Toppenish National Wildlife Refuge</u> (the United States withdrew all claims to surface water rights on the Yakima

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Firing Center). The Court held a hearing on exceptions to that report on December 8, 2005. At that hearing, in addition to the previously identified counsel, Daniel Haller appeared pro se to address his exception. The Court orally ruled on several exceptions during the hearing and in its Memorandum Opinion and Order Re: Water Rights for the United States of America, Court Claim No. 02276), filed on January 26, 2006. That Memorandum provided the parties until April 3, 2006, to respond to the Court's request in the Memorandum Opinion for additional information which might result in the Court confirming additional rights. The Court filed its Second Memorandum Opinion and Order Re: Water Rights for the United States of America, Court Claim No. 02276) on April 17, 2006, incorporating that additional information.

The Court held a hearing June 8, 2006, to consider the objections of the Department of Ecology and the United States to the Proposed Conditional Final Order and makes the following rulings. The objection filed by Ecology is DENIED. In regard to the exceptions of the United States, the Court finds:

1. Objection Re: Claim No. S4-05090

Subsequent to the June 8, 2006 hearing, the Court requested that Ecology provide the administrative record for the application for change related to the referenced claim (Exhibit Nos. SE-3 and SE-4). Having reviewed that record, the Court GRANTS the objection of the United States and the water right is amended as requested (see Attachment A).

2. Objection Re: Claim No. S4-21053

The Court GRANTS the objection of the United States related to this claim and finds that range numbers for place of use and point of diversion should be 13, not 19 and place of use is in Section 21, not Section 22.

3. Objection Re: Claim No. S4-26733

The Court DENIES the United States exception.

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4. Objection Re: Claim No. S4-24064

The Court failed to carry forth the right confirmed in regard to this claim as set forth in the January 26, 2006 Memorandum Opinion. The Court CONFIRMS that right herein (see Attachment A).

5. Additionally, while reviewing Attachment A, the Court discovered an error in describing the point of diversion for the first water right. According to the Declaration of Tom Robison (Doc #18877) the diversion is 150 feet north of the west quarter corner, not 150 feet south of the west quarter corner. That right is amended to correctly identify the point of diversion.

The Court now enters this Conditional Final Order based upon the initial Report of the Court, the Supplemental Report of the Court, the Memorandum Opinion and Order Re: Water Rights for the United States of America, Court Claim No. 02276, filed on January 26, 2006, the Second Memorandum Opinion and Order Re: Water Rights for the United States of America, Court Claim No. 02276 on April 17, 2006 and rulings set forth above. Attached to and made a part of this Conditional Final Order is a listing of the final rights confirmed to the United States Forest Service (Attachment A).

This Conditional Final Order will ultimately be incorporated into a final decree that determines and integrates all of the rights of the parties in this adjudication, at which time it shall be forwarded to the Director of the Department of Ecology for issuance of Certificates of Adjudicated Water Right.

Based on the foregoing, IT IS:

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT

1. The final decree shall include for the United States of America Toppenish Wildlife Refuge the water rights as described in the Report of the Court filed on July 15, 2004, at page 12 and for the United States Forest Service the water rights described in the Second Memorandum Opinion and Order Re: Water Rights for the

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<u>United States of America, Court Claim No. 02276</u>) on April 17, 2006 as modified by the rulings above regarding objections to the proposed conditional final order and these rights are herein entered as a Conditional Final Order.

- 2. All claims to state law based water rights before the Court pertaining to the United States of America, Toppenish Wildlife Refuge and Forest Service not so confirmed or confirmed in another Conditional Final Order are denied.
- 3. The rights herein addressed shall be administered according to this Conditional Final Order.
- 4. This Conditional Final Order, relating to the confirmation of rights and denial of claims of water rights, constitutes a final order for purposes of appeal pursuant to Civil Rule 54(b) and Rules of Appellate Procedure 2.2(d)), except for purposes of final integration of all confirmed rights as provided in Section XII of Pretrial Order No. 8 (Procedures for Claim Evaluation, dated March 3, 1989) of this Court.

- 2) With a June 30, 1912, date of priority a right to divert from an unnamed spring, 0.03 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year from June 1 to October 31 for stock watering and domestic supply in the NW¼NW¼ of Section 4, T. 13 N., R. 14 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 600 feet south and 350 feet east of the northwest corner of Section 4, being in the NW¼NW¼ of Section 4, T. 13 N., R. 14 E.W.M.
- 3) With a June 16, 1932, date of priority a right for the diversion of 0.01 cfs, 0.5 acre-foot per year from an unnamed spring for mining from May 1 to October 31 within the NE¼SE¼ of Section 31, T. 17 N., R. 11 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately 1600 feet north and 420 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 31, being within the NE¼SE¼ of unsurveyed Section 31, T. 17 N., R. 11 E.W.M.
- 4) With a July 22, 1933, date of priority a right for the diversion of 0.05 cfs, 3 acre-feet per year from an unnamed stream tributary to Lake Keechelus continuously for group domestic supply for six cabins on Lots 6 11 of Rocky Run Summer Homes in the NE½NW½ of Section 26, T. 22 N., R. 11 E.W.M. The diversion point is located approximately 200 feet south and 200 feet east of the north quarter corner of Section 26, being within the NW½NW¼NE¼ of Section 26.
- 5) With a priority date of February 28, 1939, a right to divert 0.02 cfs, 2 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring branch tributary to American River for continuous group domestic supply for the American Forks Summer Homes in the SE¼ of unsurveyed Section 12, T. 17 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is approximately 80 feet north and 200 feet east of the southwest corner of Section 12, within the SW¼SW¼ of Section 12, T. 17 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 6) With a February 21, 1940, date of priority a right to divert 0.04 cfs, 7 acre-feet per year from Salmon la Sac Creek for continuous domestic supply for a campground and guard station, including irrigation of one-half acre at the guard station, in the NW¼SW¼NE¼, NE¼NE¼NW¼, NE¼NE¼NW¼, NW¼NW¼NW¼SE¼, W½NW¼ and N½NW¼SW¼ of

Section 16, T. 22 N., R. 14 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 210 feet north and 760 feet west of the east quarter corner of Section 16, being within the SE¼NE¼ of Section 16, T. 22 N., R. 14 E.W.M.

- 7) With an April 11, 1940, date of priority a right to divert 0.20 cfs, 2 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring for continuous domestic supply for a campground at the Swauk Creek Campground in the NE¼NW¼ of Section 12, T. 21 N., R. 17 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 220 feet north and 1160 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 1, being within the SE¼SE¼ of Section 1, T. 21 N., R. 17 E.W.M.
- 8) With an August 26, 1940, date of priority a right to divert 0.01 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year from Timber Creek, tributary of American River, for single domestic supply from May 1 to October 31 on Lot 3, Timber Creek Summer Home Tracts in Section 2, T. 16 N., R. 11 E.W.M. The diversion point is 390 feet south and 100 feet west of northeast corner of Section 2, in the NE¼NE¼ of Section 2, T. 16 N., R. 11 E.W.M.
- 9) With a July 24, 1941, date of priority a right for the diversion of 0.005 cfs, 0.50 acrefoot per year for single domestic supply from May 1 to October 31 on Lot 1 of Edgewater Summer Home Lots in the NE¼NW¼ of Section 23, T.17 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion from an unnamed spring is approximately 400 feet south and 1800 feet east of the northwest corner of Section 23 (latitude 46°57'13.57", longitude 121°11'18"), being within the NE¼NW¼ of Section 23, T.17 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 10) With a January 15, 1942, date of priority a right to divert 0.05 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year from Thetis Creek for continuous domestic supply for Baker's Resort in the NE¼SW¼ of Section 32, T. 22 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 100 feet north and 200 feet west of the southeast corner of Section 31, in the SE¼SE¼ of Section 31, T. 22 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 11) With a priority date of July 21, 1944, a right for the diversion of 0.01 cfs, 0.5 acrefoot per year from an unnamed creek for continuous single domestic supply on Lot 13 of Bumping Lake Summer Homes, in Section 22, T. 16 N., R. 12 E.W.M. The point of diversion is approximately 800 feet south and 700 feet west of the center of unsurveyed Section 22, in the NE¼SW¼ of Section 22, T. 16 N., R. 12 E.W.M.
- 12) With a priority date of July 21, 1949, a right for the diversion of 0.04 cfs, 4 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring continuously for an alternate group domestic supply for Lots 9

and 10 of Russell Creek Summer Homes, in the SW½NW½ of Section 4, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 1000 feet north and 1200 feet east from the west quarter corner of Section 4, being within the SW½NW½ of Section 4, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.

- 13) With a priority date of August 20, 1958, a right to divert 0.005 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year from an unnamed spring for continuous group domestic supply for the Teanaway Summer Home Tract in the SE¼NE¼ of Section 32, T. 22 N., R. 16 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately 600 feet south and 350 feet west of the east quarter corner of Section 32, being within the NE¼NE¼SE¼ of Section 32, T. 22 N., R. 16 E.W.M.
- 14) With a priority date of August 19, 1958, a right to divert 0.13 cfs, 6 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring for continuous community domestic supply in Lots 1 through 13, Bootjack Summer Homes, located in the NE¼ of unsurveyed Section 6, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 700 feet north and 75 feet east of the south quarter corner of Section 31, being within the SW¼SE¼ of Section 31, T. 14 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 15) With a July 25, 1955, date of priority a right for the diversion of 0.01 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year for continuous single domestic supply at the Bumping Lake Boat Landing in unsurveyed SE¼NE¾ of Section 22, T. 16 N., R. 12 E.W.M. The point of diversion is approximately 1425 feet south and 1475 feet west of the northeast corner of Section 22, (latitude 46°51'59", longitude 121°18'37") being within the SW¼NE¾ of Section 22, T. 16 N., R. 12 E.W.M.
- 16) With a priority date of March 23, 1961, a right to divert 0.01 cfs, 2 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring for continuous domestic supply for the Silver Cove Resort in the NW¹/₄SW¹/₄ of unsurveyed Section 1, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately 800 feet north and 1320 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 1, being within the NW¹/₄SE¹/₄NW¹/₄ of Section 1, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 17) With an April 24, 1962, date of priority a right to divert 0.007 cfs, one-half acre-foot per year from an unnamed spring for continuous domestic supply on Lot 12, Indian Creek Summer Home Site, in unsurveyed Section 6, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately 320 feet south and 920 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 6, being with the NW¹/₄SW¹/₄ of Section 6, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 18) With a priority date of June 12, 1962, a right to divert 0.02 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year from an unnamed spring for continuous domestic supply for the Taneum Campground in the SW¼ of Section 28, T. 19 N., R. 16 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately

600 feet south and 620 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 28, being within the Government Lot 3 of Section 28, T. 19 N., R. 16 E.W.M.

- 19) With a priority date of January 31, 1963, a right to divert 0.01 cfs, 1 acre-foot per year from an unnamed spring for continuous domestic supply for two homes on Lots 18 and 20, Indian Creek Summer Home Group, in unsurveyed Section 6, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately 720 feet north and 400 feet east of the center of unsurveyed Section 6, being within the SW¹/₄NE¹/₄ of Section 6, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- **20)** With a priority date of July 3, 1968, a right for the diversion of 0.01 cfs, 2 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring tributary to Kachess Lake for continuous domestic supply on Tract 65 of the Plat of Lake Kachess Summer Home Sites, within Government Lot 2, Section 21, T. 21 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located approximately 700 feet south and 700 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 22, being within Government Lot 1 of Section 22, T. 21 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 21) With a priority date of July 18, 1974, a right to divert 0.022 cfs, 5 acre-feet per year from Cedar Creek from June 1 to October 31 for stock water in the NW¼SW¼ of Section 13, T. 19 N., R. 15 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 350 feet south and 500 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 13, being within the NW¼SW¼ of Section 13, T. 19 N., R. 15 E.W.M.
- 22) With a priority date of July 18, 1974, a right to divert 0.011 cfs, 2 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring from June 1 to October 31 for stock watering in the NE¼ of Section 21, T. 19 N., R. 15 E.W.M. The diversion point is 500 feet north and 300 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 12, in the SW¼NW¼ of Section 12, T. 17 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 32) With a priority date of August 27, 1975, a right to divert 0.04 cubic foot per second, 4 acre-feet per year from an unnamed spring continuously for an alternate group domestic supply for Lots 9 and 10 of Russell Creek Summer Homes, in the SW¼NW¼ of Section 4, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 1000 feet north and 1200 feet east from the west quarter corner of Section 4, being within the SW¼NW¼ of Section 4, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 33) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.002 cfs, 0.206 acre-foot per year from Short and Dirty Spring from July 16 to September 5 for stock watering and as required for wildlife within the SE½NE½ of Section 22, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 500 feet north and 800 feet west of the east quarter corner of Section 22, being within the SE½NE½ of Section 22, T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 34) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.004 cfs, 0.403 acre-foot per year from Glen Spring and Hart Spring July 16 to September 5 for stock watering and as required for wildlife within the NW¼SW¼ of Section 24 and the NE½SE¼ of Section 13, both in T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion from Glen Spring is located 800 feet south and 1100 feet east of the west quarter corner of Section 24, in the NW¼SW¼ of Section 24 and from Hart Spring 1800 feet north and 500 feet west from the southeast corner of Section 13, being within the NE¼SE¼ of Section 13; both in T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.
- 35) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.002 cfs, 0.12 acre-foot per year from Bethel Ridge Spring July 1 to July 13 for stock watering and as required for wildlife within the NW¼SE¼ of Section 17, T. 14 N., R. 14 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 100 feet south and 1000 feet east of the center of Section 17, being within the NW¼SE¼ of Section 17, T. 14 N., R. 14 E.W.M.
- 36) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.004 cfs, 0.17 acre-foot per year from Pine Tree Spring and Pinegrass Spring from September 6 to October 5 for stock watering and as required for wildlife in the NE¼NE¼ of Section 15 and the SE¼NW¼ of Section 16, both in T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M. The point of diversion from Pine Tree Spring is

located 1000 feet south and 1000 feet west from the northeast corner of Section 15, in the NE¼NE¼ of Section 15 and the point of diversion from Pinegrass Spring is located 700 feet north and 500 feet west of the center of Section 16, in the SE¼NW¼ of Section 16; both in T. 13 N., R. 13 E.W.M.

- 37) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.004 cfs, 0.16 acre-foot per year from Cash Prairie Spring and Greyback Spring from August 16 to September 5 for stock watering and as required for wildlife in the NW¼SE¼ of Section 12, T. 14 N., R. 13 E.W.M. and the NW¼NW¼ of Section 33, T. 15 N., R. 14 E.W.M. The point of diversion from Cash Prairie Spring is located 2000 feet north and 2000 feet west from the southeast corner of Section 12, in the NW¼SE¼ of Section 12, T. 14 N., R. 13 E.W.M. and the point of diversion from Greyback Spring is located 400 feet south and 200 feet east of the northwest corner of Section 33, being within the NW¼NW¼ of Section 33, T. 15 N., R. 14 E.W.M.
- 38) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.002 cfs, 0.13 acre-foot per year from Timberwolf Spring from June 10 to July 20 in odd years and from September 6 to September 30 in even years for stock watering and as required for wildlife in the SE¼SW¼ of Section 30, T. 15 N., R. 14 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 700 feet north and 1100 feet west from the south quarter corner of Section 30, in the SE¼SW¼ of Section 30, T. 15 N., R. 14 E.W.M.
- 39) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.002 cfs, 1.0 acre-foot per year from Deadhole Spring from June 5 to July 15 and from September 6 to October 5 for stock watering and as required for wildlife in the NW¼NE¼ of Section 35, T. 14 N., R. 14 E.W.M. The point of diversion is located 500 feet south and 700 feet east from the north quarter corner of Section 35, in the NW¼NE¼ of Section 35, T. 14 N., R. 14 E.W.M.
- 40) With a priority date of May 9, 1980, a right to divert 0.004 cfs, 0.76 acre-foot per year from Ironstone Spring and an unnamed spring from July 20 to September 30 for stock watering and as required for wildlife in the NW¼NE¼ of Section 29, T. 14 N., R. 13 E.W.M. and the NW¼SW¼ of Section 19, T. 14 N., R. 14 E.W.M.
