The north 215 feet of the following described property: That part of the E½ of Section 28, T. 16 N., R. 15 E.W.M. bounded as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of Nile Elk Ridge Addition, recorded in Volume S of Plats, page 42, records of Yakima County, Washington, said point being 30 feet S 86°13' W of the southwest corner of Lot 34 of said plat; thence N 86°13' E along the south line of said plat 630.0 feet; thence S 14°01' E 1202.6 feet; thence S 80°48' W 700 feet to the center line of the Nile Valley Road; thence northwesterly along said center line to the point of beginning.
